

Tragedy in Meron: Tens of People Killed, Over 100 Injured

YERUSHALAYIM - Over 150 people in Meron were injured with tens succumbing to their injuries during the Lag BaOmer celebrations.

As we go to print, a police spokesman confirmed that 38 people were killed. At least 69 injured were evacuated to various hospitals, 39 of them were transported to

Nahariya with 14 in serious condition. Ziv received 46 injured, with four in critical condition. A total of five were evacuated to Rambam Kerem in critical condition, and one was transported to Poria in moderate condition, with five in light condition.

The tragedy in Meron occurred in the area where the Toldos Aharon Rebbe, *shlita*, was conducting a

hadlakah. Six helicopters were sent to assist with evacuation of the injured.

United Hatzalah volunteer EMT Yosef Chaim Ben Tzion, one of the first responders at the scene, and who participated in the CPR, relayed, "A number of the injured are in critical condition and a large number of people were moderately injured after a grandstand collapsed with dozens of

people on it. Doctors, paramedics, and EMTs from United Hatzalah who were providing medical security for the event rushed to respond and initiated CPR on a number of individuals while treating the others for their injuries."
